

INTERNSHIP SUPERVISOR APPLICATION Eligibility:

This application is for current DCFS employees who wish to apply as an internship supervisor. In order to qualify, individuals must hold a bachelor’s degree or master’s degree and must have, at minimum, 2 years of successful experience with DCFS. Due to current University and CSWE rules, individuals who supervise social work students should hold a BSW or MSW from a CSWE accredited program and must hold an active Louisiana RSW, LMSW, or LCSW license. Please note, BSW students can be supervised by BSW level employees, whereas MSW students should be supervised by MSW level employees Student placements can be made with non-social work employees on an individual basis. Individuals who do not meet the criteria are NOT discouraged from applying. Applications are received on an ongoing basis.
